

2022 LIBRARY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Sponsored by the Friends of Lake Villa District Library

DESCRIPTION:

The Friends of Lake Villa District Library will award three \$1,000 scholarships to three qualifying high school seniors graduating in 2022.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Current resident of Lake Villa Township
- 2. Graduating high school senior in 2022
- 3. After 2022 graduation, student plans to pursue a two or four degree at any accredited vocational school, junior college or university

HOW TO APPLY:

Scholarship applications are available at www.lvdl.org/friends and/or with your Guidance Counselor at your high school. **Application deadline is Tuesday, March 15, 2022.**

SELECTION:

Applications will be read and discussed by LVDL Friends Scholarship Committee.

Five finalists will be selected from the pool of applications.

Finalist will be required to attend an interview on Saturday, May 7, 2022.

Scholarships will be presented to the recipients at their high school awards night.

FRIENDS OF LAKE VILLA DISTRIC LIBRARY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

PROCEDURE:

To be eligible for the Friends of Lake Villa District Library college/school scholarship, the high school senior must **complete** and **sign** the official scholarship application and provide all items in the following Application Checklist.

- OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS
- VERIFIED, UNWEIGHTED CUMULATIVE GPA OR SAT SCORE
- TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION
 - ONE FROM SCHOOL (TEACHER, GUIDANCE COUNSELOR ETC.)
 - ONE PERSONAL (NON FAMILY MEMBER)
- COLLEGE/SCHOOL LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE OR WAIT LIST LETTER
- PERSONAL STATEMENT
- AWARDS AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES LIST

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

In order for your application to be considered, **ALL components of your application packet MUST be received or postmarked by Tuesday, March 15, 2022.**

Any missing documentation will **DISQUALIFY** your application.
